A PERSONAL PRAYER

Heavenly Father, in this prayer I want to speak to You about myself. I pray that it is not a selfish prayer, for my ultimate goal is to be right with You. Please make a way for me to avoid sin and help me to accept Your forgiveness when I do sin. I long to be right with You. Direct my steps to always be in the path of righteousness.

Father, help me recognize the work You have given me to do, and assist me as I try to glorify You. Stamp Your name on my heart so that I may live eternally in Your presence.

LIGHTING THE DARK

The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light. Romans 13:12

Heavenly Father, this valley that I walk in has two different aspects depending on the angle of the sun. In the evening, the shadow of a hill casts the valley into deep gloom. But in the early hours of the day, the valley is bright because it faces the morning sun.

Father, what a difference the sun makes in the natural world, and what a difference when I see my life with the light You provide! When I walk through dark passages in my life, I pray that my eyes will be opened to the illumination that You provide. Give me a positive outlook to overcome the dreary times. Keep me in the light of Your blessings.

WHAT UPSETS YOU?

For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would. GALATIANS 5:17

Heavenly Counselor, I encounter many problems each day. Sometimes they arise from the simple struggles of daily life, like a car with a dead battery or a home with a faulty hot water tank. Keep me from becoming upset because of inanimate objects. Sometimes I have conflicts with people whose business objectives are different from mine. Help me refuse to act improperly in daily give-and-take with others. I too struggle with my own limitations, like forgetfulness. May I never become frustrated by my lack of proficiency.

Father, one conflict I especially want to avoid is one with the Holy Spirit. May I never work against Your purposes.

OPEN-DOOR POLICY

Thou shalt guide me with thy counsel, and afterward receive me to glory. PSALM 73:24

Lord, I once had a supervisor who had an opendoor policy. Whenever I was torn about the best course of action to solve a problem, I would spend a few minutes talking with him. Sometimes he would suggest an option; sometimes he would caution me against an option.

I am thankful, Father, that You have an opendoor policy. I can talk to You day or night about the things that trouble me. It is a comfort to know that You are there to listen. I know that You will make clear to me the correct decision.

SETTING A COURSE

What man is he that feareth the Lord? him shall he teach in the way that he shall choose. PSALM 25:12

Lord, I watch the rain and see two raindrops fall only inches apart: one flows to the right, the other flows to the left.

Unlike the raindrops, I have the liberty to choose which direction my life flows. Heavenly Father, keep me from making careless judgments that can develop into frightful consequences. Guide me to choices that lead away from the darkness of sin and into the light of righteousness. Give me Your wisdom as I make choices. I pray that my decisions are based on the values instilled in me by studying Your Word.

TRUST IN THE LORD

Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. PROVERBS 3:5

Father, on the way to work I saw a high-rise office building under construction. At dizzying heights, the workers appeared unconcerned as they walked on narrow ribbons of steel. That is something I could not do. Yet, set the same steel beam a few inches above the ground, and I could walk across it without concern.

Father, when I am apprehensive about tasks that need to be done, remind me that Your protective hand is under me. I pray that I will learn to step out in faith, secure in the knowledge that You are there for me.

OVERCOMING FEAR

Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit you like men, be strong. 1 CORINTHIANS 16:13

Father, I pray that I can overcome fears that hinder me from following in Your footsteps. Fear makes me a liar: I excuse myself by claiming that I don't know how or that I'm not ready. Fear makes me a pretender: I can be fainthearted or hesitant, and I call it patience.

Regardless of the nature of my anxiety, I must press ahead. Lord, may I embrace Your Word in order to drive out irrational concerns that trouble my heart. I pray that I will not allow fear to paralyze me.

GIVING WISE COUNSEL

Behold, God exalteth by his power: who teacheth like him? JOB 36:22

Lord, the opportunity to shape other lives is both a blessing and an awesome responsibility. Show me how to admonish, correct, and inspire those who come to me for guidance, whether it be at work, at church, or in the community. Help me build relationships founded on trust.

Lord, no one teaches like You; regardless of the circumstances, I pray I will ground my advice in Your Word. Give me the dedication and calm self-assurance to help the people I am mentoring realize higher objectives for their lives. I pray that they will have the conviction to remain on course when I am no longer guiding them.

LOVING UNITY

Can two walk together, except they be agreed? Amos 3:3

Dear Lord, I am disheartened to encounter disagreement among those who profess to believe in You: fractured denominations, split congregations, and individuals who no longer speak to one another. We should be pulling together. Unfortunately, I confess that because of my own obstinacy, I have contributed to the lack of harmony.

Lord, I pray that I will be more agreeable, that I will not be arrogant or unreasonable. Guide me to choose the right words that will lead to a better walk with You and with my brothers and sisters in Christ. Remind me that even if I am right, I can still be wrong if my comments are not wrapped in love.

INTELLECTUAL APPEAL

The simple believeth every word: but the prudent man looketh well to his going. PROVERBS 14:15

Lord, every day my eyes and ears are assailed by those who want to bend my will to their purposes. Testimonies from famous personalities, glittering television advertisements, and half-truths of insincere politicians are all trying to muddle my reasoning so I cannot distinguish between truth and lies. They want me to listen and not ask questions.

Father, help me use the abilities You have given me to carefully evaluate the claims of those who try to influence me. I appreciate that You appeal to my intellect as well as my emotions. You tell me to work out my own salvation and try the spirits to see if they are from You. Give me discernment in spiritual and everyday matters.

PURPOSE
